


KNOWING JESUS AS THE RESURRECTION AND THE LIFE



JOHN 11:1-44

**I. Jesus saw the
glory of God, even
when His friend was
dying
(John 11:1-6).**



- **What reasons would Jesus have, to delay healing “the one who is your friend?”**
- **How should His eternal perspective affect ours?**

II. Jesus was focused on more than just the resurrection of Lazarus (v.11-15).



- How could the rising of Lazarus be for the sake of His disciples?
- How is the rising of Lazarus for our sakes?

III. Jesus declared to Martha that He is the resurrection and the life (v. 17-26).



- **What hope did Jesus offer to Martha that didn't involve Lazarus?**
- **What hope should we now have in Jesus already being the resurrection?**

**IV. 'The resurrection
and the life' is
moved to tears by
seeing love
(v.33-37).**



- **Since Jesus knew what He was going to do, why did He still weep?**
- **How does it affect you to think that our love can move Jesus to tears?**

V. Jesus clearly demonstrates His power of resurrection (v. 38-44).



- How amazing would it have been to stand there and witness this resurrection?
- What amazing resurrections have you witnessed?
- What amazing resurrections do you long to witness?
