**I. The life of Jesus

**–John 12:20-22.**

## IV. God loudly announced that Jesus glorifies the Father (v.27-30).

- What is the struggle of Jesus here and in the Garden of Gethsemane?
- What would you have experienced if you had been there to hear God's voice?
- How is that voice still uttered for our sakes?



**V. Because Jesus is  
'lifted up,' He draws all  
men to Him (v.31-36).**
