TITUS 3:3-11

**I. When we were in terrible need
of kindness, He appeared
(Titus 3:3-4).**



- How great was our need for ‘the Kindness of God?’
- Why would the apostle Paul describe Jesus as “the kindness of God?”

II. The kindness of God saved us when we were undeserving (v.5-7).



- If Jesus blessed us when we were undeserving, what is our task?
- What is the role of the Holy Spirit in this whole process?
- As heirs, what 'torch' has been passed to us?

III. The kindness of God saved us so we can become His kindness (v.8).



- What happens when we are ‘careful to engage in good things?’
- How careful are we about being kindness?
- What happens in my day when my goal is to ‘be profitable for all men?’

IV. If we are to be the kindness of God, we need to avoid arguing (v.9).



- How does arguing get in the way of being the kindness of God?
- How does living as 'the kindness of God' help us see arguing as foolishness?

**V. The kindness of God rejects those who cause divisions
(v.10-11).**



- **Why does kindness warn those who are ‘self-condemned?’**
- **Why would the kindness of God reject a person who causes division?**
