IV. The Lamb is to reside in your home (v.3, 6).

- **How can we do a better job of letting the Lamb reside in our homes?**

**V. Every household is
protected by the Lamb
(v.7).**



- **What was accomplished by the spreading of the blood of the lamb?**
- **What is accomplished by spreading the message of the blood of the Lamb?**

VI. You partake of the Lamb with a purpose to go out (v.8-11).



- **Why would God want them to eat the Passover meal in the way they did?**
- **How does God want us to partake of His supper?**
